

Mid-Year Updates

City of Gaffney

The city of Gaffney sent out a public notice in May about mosquito spraying. The Public Works Department sprays the city public streets in June and continues until October. This program works to mitigate the risk of mosquito borne illnesses. They spray in the evenings from dusk until about 11pm. Residents who have honeybees should contact the supervisor if they don't want treatment in their areas.

Greenville County

Greenville County has a mosquito control and prevention program which helps residents with education and prevention. The county has a spray tip line which residents can call for assistance during June until September. Residents who receive treatments will be notified of completion. The County doesn't treat private ponds, including HOA owned retention ponds.

Greenwood County Lake Management

Greenwood County Lake Management conducts larviciding treatments on Lake Greenwood in Greenwood, Laurens and Newberry Counties. This small-scale larviciding program is performed by boats and the use of Altosid briquettes. So far, to date, the Lake Management staff have performed 2 larvidicing treatments on the lake. They answer complaints from lake-front residents and have site inspections of the lake-front properties. This year, staff have educated residents about reducing mosquito habitat. In June, our Lake Specialist II, Win Ott, attended the Summer Workshop. This workshop was a great educational experience, and Win brought back information that he learned.

City of North Myrtle Beach

Hello everyone, we have had a very hot summer. We continue to be a little below average on complaints and our mosquito population. Our crew has worked hard this summer with catch basin treatments and handling the few complaints we have had. We look forward to seeing everyone in November at the annual Meeting.

Johnny Bruton

Dorchester County

Greetings from Dorchester County Mosquito Control Department, we are gearing up to tackle yet another successful season of mosquito abatement. My name is Martez Morris. I am the Mosquito and Pest Control Coordinator for Dorchester County Neighborhood Services, I have approximately 4 years in Pest Control experience. I'm celebrating my two-year mark with the Dorchester family and very happy to be here. Helping people has always been my passion and I'm dedicated to making this year even better than last year. Our goal is to reduce the number of mosquitos in a more cost effective and environmentally safe way and help educate the citizens each year. Dorchester County operates a Mosquito Control Program to protect its citizens from the spread of mosquito-borne diseases by spraying pesticides (insecticides), applying larvicide to low-lying areas, and educating its citizens on reducing the conditions that foster increases in the mosquito population.

This year we have experienced a lot of rain, much more than last year. Although we've had a lot of rain this season so far, we are still doing everything we can to keep mosquitos to a minimum. This year we have used approximately 926.4 gallons of chemical with over 100 Larvicide treatments. I'm working side by side with one of our newest mosquito sprayers on light traps & LRC Data collections 2 to 3 times a week. I have to say I have an amazing team.

Successful mosquito management requires intervening at some point during the mosquito's life cycle before they bite and infect a human. Last year we have worked on educating citizens to better understand ways to prevent and protect them for the mosquito population. As the season is in full swing, we are continuing to monitor and help reduce mosquito breeding grounds.

Mid-Year Updates

Charleston County Mosquito Control

After a typically quiet opening two months of 2023, the mosquito season started here with a bang in March. 268 requests for service were received, and 80,357 acres were treated by ULV spray trucks, a greater total than both April and May. Purchased and installed in both MD-500 helicopters during March was the Spider Tracks GPS real-time flight tracking system, which adds a significant measure of monitoring safety to the operations of the program's helicopter group. Adult and larval stage control activities continue at a high level to date, including two airplane adulticiding missions to the McClellanvile/South Santee region. Joint Base Charleston also carried out an aerial adulticiding spraying treatment, on May 16 to the U.S. Naval Weapons Station. With assistance of staff from Clarke Mosquito Control, the program droplet calibrated the adulticide spraying system of the designated helicopter May 22 utilizing the newly acquired DropVision Basic system. That aircraft conducted our first ever helicopter adulticiding spray mission June 29. The groundbreaking ceremony for the new Charleston County Public Works/Mosquito Control (PW/MC) headquarters was held May 16 on a property adjacent to the current location of the Azalea Drive Mosquito Control headquarters. Completion of the 89,000 square foot (37,000 for PW/MC), 57 million dollar facility is scheduled for spring of 2026..

Myrtle Beach Mosquito Control

We have our first case of West Nile this season, early for us. James Brock from the county called to offer any assistance and sympathy, always appreciated. We are following the DEHC protocols as best we can and we are waiting for test results from our trapping. I hope that this is not an omen for the rest of the season. We have more new neighborhoods coming online stretching our spray schedule to the limit, but we will manage. That's all for know.

Horry County

Greetings from Horry County! Hope this finds you all well. As I am sure you all know, it has been a really wet spring and summer! Weather conditions have ramped up mosquito populations. However, we have been vigilant in our efforts to protect the community in spite of those weather conditions. We have been inundated with service requests and are addressing those in a timely manner. We are spraying by truck each night that weather permits. In the months of June and July, we flew 8 aerial missions. We are continuing to larvicide areas that have standing water, roadside ditches and catch basins. We are currently posting a position for a new full time Mosquito Technician and are adding a new truck and driver to our team. All is quiet as far as storms/hurricanes at this time and I certainly hope it remains that way. Take care and be safe out there!


